**Sponsorship Fee:** \$200 (non-refundable, includes ALL mandatory and any/or all optional categories contestants want to participate plus two program books; these are nice for a keepsake for the contestant and a thank you for the sponsor.)

**Sponsorship Fee Payable to:** Greater Pink Hill LLC

A contestant may be sponsored by parent(s), a Business or Civic Sponsor (this option will help curb the parents' expenses).

Funds, after pageant expenses, raised through the pageant will be funneled into the community, not funding one specific charity, but helping to meet needs throughout the community.

A receipt for sponsorship can be given.

**Each contestant must sell at least a ONE PAGE AD in the program book.**

(This page can be a combination of all ad sizes (except the business card size) to equal a page; it can be a personal ad of best wishes from family or friends and/or businesses advertising their business services.

ONE full page of ads can be any combination of one page (excludes business card ad sizes/these ads will be in program books after other ads): photos can be included on all ads except business card ads-the business card ads will be scanned.

four 1/4 pages; two 1/2 pages; A 1/2 page and two 1/4 pages; or one whole page.

**There will be a simple opening number/ introduction of contestants at the beginning of the pageant. Contestants will wear short sleeve or cap sleeves black shirt (no glitz or stone embellishments) white capris, and white tennis shoes.**

**Children 5 or under can wear white shorts, if capris cannot be found in their sizes.**

(Capris can normally be found online, if not in local dept. stores.)The black shirts are not to be embellished, cut, or altered. Parents of girls 8 & under may add bows or ribbon.

Any age who enjoy wearing bows in their hair can wear them in the hair.If length of shirt is too long, contestant may tie or pull to the side with bow or ribbon.

**There will be a \$6 general admission fee to the pageant.**

**\*\*Three admission tickets will be given to each contestant's parent**-these will be for parents/family/friends, whomever the parent chooses to have them.

(Most pageants give 1-2 tickets which includes the chaperone/backstage pass).

**\*\*One dressing room attendant ticket will be given to each Contestant as the Adult Chaperone pass-helping with dress, hair, clothing change, etc.**

**An adult chaperone (18+) must accompany anyone 9 or under @ all times until/ except when they go backstage.** Backstage space is limited so unless Child is of age they must have an adult with them at this time, we request you watch from audience and then meet them back at the dressing room or at the entrance to the stage door for those 9& under.

No others including friends or grandparents will be allowed in the dressing room as space is limited. **Only females will be allowed as chaperones and allowed in dressing rooms.**

**Everyone is responsible to take all their trash out of the dressing rooms-they need to be left the way they are found as classes resume in these rooms on Monday, May 7th.**

**Any Reigning Queens entering doors with crown or medallion and/or current sash will be admitted free. Chaperones must pay.**

**2017-2018 Pink Hill Greater Pink Hill Queens & parents will not be charged admission. These tickets will be given out in advance or held at the door. These are not transferable to other people-friends or relatives.**

**Note: No contestants in any age category can have ever been married or with child.**

**Title winners will receive a round crown, sash, and flowers.**

**Runner-ups will receive a trophy.**

***All contestants will receive a participation medallion.***

**Mandatory Competition Categories/Overall (highest points) will receive a medallion.**

**Contestants must reside in Eastern North Carolina, parents be prepared if child wins, to sign an agreement of participation in the community service activities, the annual Tea Party, participate/attend Christmas on the Hill (3-6pm night before the parade), unless represented in a school group to ride in the Pink Hill Christmas Parade as a title holder, and attend as many community or local events as possible.**

**We do know circumstances such as sickness & other activities can occur preventing participation in some things but the title holder should make this one of their priorities, not the last one. The agreement will also ask that each title holder have a simple solid black Sunday/Street length dress as well as a royal blue one (photo can be provided of color/not needing to be identical, just very close in color that can be worn at any occasion so the Court can match on certain occasions. The white capris & black shirt will be worn, and jeans at times as well as each time holder will be given a Greater Pink Hill Court Black T-shirt purchased by Greater Pink Hill (Moms/Grandmothers can get one for \$20) that can be worn with jeans, and the white capris so we can match at certain events. This is the first time we have required this of the winners, but other area Courts have always required it. Courts do look beautiful when their colors match at events and looks beautiful in photo shoots.**

**Note: Astericks \* & \*\***

**\*The Greater Pink Hill Ambassador will be selected from the present court based on appearances, community service projects, etc. This child will not know until the evening of the pageant. The Ambassador will receive a sash & serve with the 2018-2019 Court, just as if they were crowned that evening. This person will have the transfer of their sash to the new title sash.**

**\*\*The Greater Pink Hill Princess and Greater Pink Hill Prince will be chosen by the Pink Hill Elementary School to be crowned during a school assembly/function by members of the 2018 Greater Pink Hill Court and with permission of the parents of the two representing the titles, will serve with the Greater Pink Hill Queens Court. Greater Pink Hill LLC will be providing the crowns and sashes for both these titles. The Princess will receive a matching tiara and the Prince will receive a jester's style crown. The fundraising criteria for these two titles will be set by the school, take place in the Spring, and all funds will be kept by the school. Greater Pink Hill LLC thought this would be an excellent way to help the principal fund school projects not provided through the school's budget & serve as one of the 2018-2019 Court Community Service Projects.**

**Four Mandatory Areas of Competition:**

**(1) *\*\*Evening Gown/Long Dress Modeling-Little Miss & up (30 Points)***

Age appropriate- no low cut strapless dresses, strapless can be deemed appropriate for Miss and Ms age categories-if in doubt ask the Director- judges low score those wearing inappropriate age dresses and those if age appropriate doesn't look becoming to ones' body type.

***\*\*Pageant Cupcake Dress, Party Dress, Flower Girl Dress or Long Dress:  
parent preference: for Petite Miss & Under***

**(2) *Talent: Petite Miss and up (35 Points)***

**Music on CDs only!** NO IPODS OR PHONES WILL BE ACCEPTED. (It's always recommended to have two CDs and an emergency backup can be on the phone. The CD/TALENT Talent CANNOT exceed 3 minutes or 10 points will be deducted.

**Most talent in pageants are 1&1/2 to 2minutes.**

**Talent/costume must be age & performance attire appropriate.**

**No duplication of music. First contestant who enters gets the song/music. (ONLY EXCEPTION-IF ONE PERFORMS A MUSICAL PIECE ON A MUSICAL INSTRUMENT AND ONE DANCES.) THIS NEEDS TO BE ENTERED IN BLANK AREA LISTING FOR TALENT WHEN APPLICATION IS TURNED IN.**

**Talent can be but not limited to dance, singing, cheer routine, color guard flag routine(keep in mind ceiling could be issue), art-painting or drawing, playing a musical instrument, mime, drama, monologue, recitation such as a poem, a creative way of educating the judges on a specific talent/subject/activity, etc. ENDLESS POSSIBILITIES.**

**Contestant may use props during this phase of competition.**

**(Talent to be approved by Director.)**

Judges look at each individual separately-there is no re-judging or changing of scores. Each contestant is judged on their own talent not compared to others. Once scores are made per contestant they move on to the auditor. The judges look at knowledge, ability and difficulty based on age, performance, attire for performance, etc.

**Deadline for providing Pageant Committee with THE CD IS Friday, April 27th.**

**All music must be on CD marked with your name and song title. For every day after the 27th, 1 Point will be deducted from the judges total dance score.**

**CD WILL BE RETURNED IN ENVELOPE WITH JUDGES SCORE SHEETS.**

**(2) *Storybook Character/Movie Character: Mini Miss & Under (replaces talent for this age group--35 Points.)*** Dress as favorite character, **no duplications**, first come gets Character choice. Character needs to be written in the space on application listed for talent. Contestant may use props during this phase of competition.

**Type or Print in a paragraph why you and your child chose to dress as the character & why. This can be turned in through text, Facebook messenger, or emailed by pageant entry deadline on Friday, March 30th. Each day after the 30th the write up is late, 1 Point will be deducted from the judges total score.**

**(3) Interview: Petite Miss-Ms Age Categories (20 Points)**

The interview/conversation of the contestant with the judges, beginning probably at noon depending on number of entries will be on Saturday May 5th, prior to the pageant. This will be approximately 3-5 minutes. Each judge will be given a copy of the application, so print or type it neatly.

**\*\*\*\*Wear OPENING PERFORMANCE ATTIRE for Interviews !!!! Do not wear normal pageant interview attire.** This will put ALL contestants dressed in the same colors which is good for judges and will cut costs for parents.

**(3) Casual Wear modeling: Mini Miss & Under (20 Points)**

**THEME WEAR- IT'S SUMMERTIME!**

**(Casual Wear Competition replaces the interview category for this age group.)**

**Contestants may use props/action during this phase of competition.** The clothes must be off the rack/had been purchased. Altered is okay but not seamstress made.

The casual wear should be age appropriate.

**(4) Fitness Wear: ALL AGES (15 Points)**

**Fitness Attire chosen by contestants' Moms are to be worn with tennis shoes.**

Fitness attire can be dance/workout shorts, dance/workout capris, or long dance/workout pants with dance tops-any colors that match personality-***bows are ok for any age BUT PROPS are ok for Mini Miss and Under. This is a much faster walk, not casual or evening modeling style-this is like a walk with a bounce. (No routine is allowed-points will be deducted if contestant does a routine.)***

**Each contestant may strike a pose/athletic stance at the ending X.**

**Most Optional Areas of Competition, ALL covered in the ENTRY FEE** are not judged by our pageant panel of judges but by judges prior to the pageant chosen in the area of expertise of category

**(1)Poem or Art- Subject: "Pink Hill"**

Poems can be Factual/Fictional/Rhyming.

Poem or Art must be contestant's work-**no parent's help** unless it's in the typing & printing of the poem. Art can be on an 8x10 or 11x14 Sketch Paper or Painted On a Canvass. **Winner will receive a trophy.**

**(2) Community Service Award: Petite – Ms Categories)**

Community Service has to ***have been completed at least 3 weeks prior to the pageant and within a year of the date of the pageant.***

**A one-typed page describing the service project**, including what part the contestant did in the project and the impact of completing the project affected the contestant. (this is an Individual project not a group or church group project).

**The winner will receive a plaque.**

**(3) Best Dress -- All ages**

This area of competition will be judged by our panel of pageant judges separate from the formal wear modeling so the judges can concentrate only on the dress. Best Dress has nothing to do with their modeling ability.

**Winner will receive a medallion.**

Best Dress is the Judging of the dress only on stage in front of judges, NOT the contestant's modeling ability.

#### **(4) Photogenic/Program Book Cover Contest (All Ages)**

**SUBMIT 1 headshot or head & shoulder-(Color or black & white 8x10, no retouch).**

**The photo will be printed in Black Black & White of winning photos on the Program Book.**

**\*\*Photogenic will be judged by professional photographers, not our pageant judges so these must be turned in by Saturday, April 6th.** These can be the same photos or different photos needed for the program book for contestant photos. Please indicate if we should use this on social media introduction of contestants and program book or if you would be providing a different photo to be used for the program book and social media, which needs to be turned in by April 6th, too.

If you want to use a different photo just indicate which one for competition and the one for the program book.

**NOTE: No photos will be accepted for competition after APRIL 6th. No photos will be accepted after April 6th for program book-a crown will be in their spot. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

**(6) People's Choice Award (All Ages)**

Bring a decorated container prepared as instructed below.

**The decorated containers can be a WOW in the competition. A first place, second place, and third place ribbon will be placed on the containers once the competition of People's Award ends when intermission is over.**

**The Recipient of the People's Choice Award will receive a medallion - bring an *unbreakable container* (example:jar/box) *with a wallet or 5x7 size photo of the contestant displayed on it.* The container WITH the most money after intermission will be the People's Choice Award Winner. The recipient will receive a trophy. (See info below about advanced sell of program books to count toward People's Choice Award)**

**Program Books: \$6.00**

***Program books if sold by contestants/purchased in advance by Saturday, April 21st, the money will be tallied and dollar amount placed in the Contestant People's Choice Container to go toward the People's Choice Award the night of the pageant.***

No program books sold after the 21st will be added into this count.

**Note: CONTESTANT REFERRALS**

If a contestant ***refers someone*** who enters the pageant listing your name on their application, the contestant ***will receive \$20 in their envelope with their score sheets***



at the end of the pageant and CD if they have one. This is for **the first referral only- additional referrals will not receive a monetary cash back of \$20 but each referral will count below.**

**(Current Contestants can enter the upcoming pageant.)**

The most Referrals by applicants who list the names of a 2018-2019 contestant or list the name of a present 2017-2018 Queen/Princess/Prince/Ambassador will receive a \$25 Visa Card that will be presented on pageant night. ***The one with the most referrals must be listed on the application in the referral space on their Contestant Application*** in order to be in the competition to ***receive the \$25 Visa Card at the pageant.*** This is open only to a paid contestant or member of the present court. **Note:** Once all applications are received, there will be a schedule of times to be at the school on pageant day Saturday, May 5th, rehearsal opportunities, and exact time of pageant day times including start time of pageant competition which is tentatively set for 3pm (with interviews starting about noon).

**Note:** Broken crowns: replacement fee: cost of crown, tax, and shipping is responsibility of parent or guardian. It's strongly SUGGESTED crowns are kept in a container such as a CROWN CASE (some can be found in Target, Walmart, Claires, or online-any multi use container-does not have to be called a crown box but it is suggested to have a handle for ease of transporting it from place to place and for storage) out of reach of a child nor kept on dresser (can be knocked off) when not in use. Crowns are VERY VERY fragile and not guaranteed BY ANY COMPANY except to arrive UNBROKEN.
